Race Squad News

The Christmas and New Years period is the championship season for youth and junior sailing which means our squad members have been travelling through NSW and QLD competing at a range of events. While some sailors are still competing, others have finished and had some fantastic results. Reports and Results are below.

Sail Sydney – Georges River Sailing Club, Sydney, NSW

Represented by a massive total of 14 420s and Optimists, Middle Harbour performed extremely well at this championship. In the International 420, Xavier and Conor were our highest placed boat in 3rd place, with James and Tom (5th), Kirsty and Ed (6th) and Mara and Georgia (7th) all close behind. Middle Harbour was represented by over half the fleet at this regatta, securing our position as the home of 420s in Sydney. Ten Middle Harbour Optimists travelled to this regatta and like the 420s strong results were recorded. The highest placed MHYC boat was Charlotte in 6th place, closely followed by Max (8th), Hugo (17th), Pia (19th), Hannah (21st), Campbell (27th), Harrison (28th) and Jenson (30th). In the Silver Fleet, John Mark placed an amazing 2nd with Saxon showing great potential in 7th place. These were fantastic results for our young sailors – Well done all!!!

International 420 National Championship – Moreton Bay Boat Club, Brisbane, QLD

Held last week, Middle Harbour Yacht Club was represented by two boats at this event. Both James and Tom, and Xavier and Conor sailed consistently during the event with both boats recording top 10 finishes. Xavier and Conor's final placing was 13th, with James and Tom not far behind in 24th place. This is a great effort for both boats in their first year in the International 420 against older and more experienced local and international crews. The championship was won by Singaporean crew D Choy and N Tang.

Australian Youth Championships – Royal Queensland Yacht Squadron, Brisbane, QLD

This event commenced on Saturday, with Middle Harbour crews of James and Tom, and Xavier and Conor competing in the International 420 division. So far the boys are sailing hard with Tom and James in 20st place and Xavier and Conor in 9th after recording a top result of 7th. We wish the boys the best of luck for the coming days of racing.
