Decision

Facts Found

- Protest Tenacity v Llama II was found to be invalid as it was lodged after the time limit.
- Protest Llama II vTenacity was found to be valid as there was serious damage that was obvious to both boats.
- Both boats on starboard, Tenacity clear ahead of Llama II.
- Tenacity tacked onto port and was then on a collision course with Llama II.
- Llama II attempted to avoid Tenacity by bearing away, at the same time Tenacity tacked back onto starboard.
- A collision occurred between the bow of Llama II and the stern of Tenacity.

Conclusion and rules that apply

- Tenacity as either tacking boat or boat that had just completed their tack did not keep clear or give room for Llama II to keep clear.
- RRS 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 61.1(a)(4)

Decision

• Tenacity retired from the race and so no further penalty is applicable.
