A trophy awarded to the winner of Annual Pointscore in the Offshore Division (Ocean Series) on IRC.




The Nigel Holman Perpetual Trophy

Donated by MHYC Members and friends of Nigel Holman in November 2007. Nigel's yacht "Cuckoos Nest" won the CYCA's Tattersall's Cup for Overall Winner on Corrected Time in the 49th Sydney to Hobart Yacht Race. The 1993 Hobart was one of the toughest races ever in the history of this Blue Water Classic, from a total starting fleet of 104 by race end 67 yachts had pulled out due to the rough conditions.

A trophy presented to the winning yachts in each Division. The Front Up Cup is the opening feature event of the new sailing season.


