#### **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

It is recommended that all competitors access the Sailing Instructions from the NSW 9er Classes website, and print of their own hard copy. Sailing Instructions will only be available online, when downloaded.

#### 8 COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward courses as described in the Sailing Instructions'.

#### 9 PENALTIES

For all classes – RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

#### 10 SCORING

10.1 A maximum of 14 races to be completed over the weekends are scheduled, of which 4 (four) races shall constitute a series.

10.2 Series Scores: will be

- (a) When there are 6 or fewer races completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from 7 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When from 11 to 14 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

#### 11 PRIZES

Prizes will also be awarded as follows:

#### 29er & 49erFX & 49er

1st to 3rd on Scratch Overall

The Perpetual Trophies and NSW State Title will only be awarded to competitors registered NSW sailing club and NSW 9er Classes Association members.

#### 29er Only

- 1st Youth Team (Not attain their 19th birthday by the 31st December 2019, both skipper and crew).
- 1st Junior Team (Not attain their 17th birthday by the 31st December 2019, both skipper and crew).
- 1st Female Skipper (with male crew)
- 1st All Female Team
