- (a) The host yacht club is Middle Harbour Yacht Club. (MHYC)
- (b) To enter, email Sailing Administrator Catherine Rofe (sailing@mhyc.com.au) by Wednesday 29th January 2020, stating your boat name, contact details & the boats expected arrival to MHYC. **An audited Special Regulations Category 7 and Conditions of Entry form shall be submitted prior to competing in the regatta.**
- (c) The entry fee for the Regatta is AUD\$1,500. This shall be paid to the International MC38 Class Association Inc. via transfer to the association's Westpac Bank BSB No: 032 102, Account No: 971912.
- (d) Further to 2020 Season NoR 5, boats shall be berthed at MHYC Competitor berthing facilities will be available from Friday 31 January to Monday 3rd February 2020 at no additional fee. Facilities for race yachts (and any other vessels) must be pre-booked by contacting Matt Pyne 9969-1244 or matt@mhyc.com.au.
- (e) **Addendum Q shall not apply. This amends Season NOR 2.1.**
- (f) Signals made ashore shall be displayed on the main flag mast on the MHYC Start Box.
- (g) The Official Notice Board is at the entrance to the club.
- (h) The VHF channel shall be channel 72.
- (i) Refer to NOR 5.5 regarding crew weights. It is a requirement that all crews weigh in and record weights for the 2020 series at Act 1 MHYC
- (j) The schedule of events is as follows:

- (j) The description of the marks in the NoR and General SI 8 are replaced with the following:
 1. The starting line will be between the signal mast of the Race Committee Signal Boat displaying an orange flag and the course side of yellow inflatable mark on the port end of the line.
 2. The finishing line will be between the signal mast of the Committee Vessel displaying an orange flag and a yellow inflatable mark nearby.
 3. **Mark 1 will be an orange inflatable buoy with a white band.**
 4. **The Gate marks will be orange inflatable buoys.**
 5. Mark 1a (the offset mark) will be a yellow inflatable buoy.
 6. The "Change Mark" will be an orange inflatable buoy with black band.
