## Suspension of racing further extended until August 28

Keelboat and Centreboard Racing at MHYC is suspended until at least Saturday 28 August 2021 in line with today's updated NSW Government Public Health Orders further extending the Covid-19 Lockdown.

The following additional races are abandoned or postponed:

- The Pacific Rigging Wednesday Non-Spinnaker Series 4 will have insufficient races to constitute a series. Races 9, 10, 11 & 12 are abandoned. Race 13 on 1 September is scheduled to be sailed as non-pointscore.
- The Winter Sprint Series will have insufficient races to constitute a series and is abandoned.

- The Leading Edge Pursuit Series is abandoned.
- Centreboard Winter Series races on August 8 and 22 are postponed. The next scheduled racing for the Optimist class is the Combined Clubs Optimist Winter Series at RSYS on 29 August. The next scheduled racing for 29er class is at HHSC on 29 August.
