APPENDIX FOR THE NOR AND SI'S FOR THE 2021 SERIES

- (a) The host yacht club is Middle Harbour Yacht Club. (MHYC)
- (b) To enter, email MHYC Sailing Administrator Catherine Rofe (sailing@mhyc.com.au) by Wednesday 3rd November 2021, stating your boat name, contact details & the boats expected arrival to MHYC. **An audited Special Regulations Category 7 and Conditions of Entry form shall be submitted prior to competing in the regatta.**
- (c) The entry fee for the Regatta is AUD\$2,000. This shall be paid to the International MC38 Class Association Inc. via transfer to the association's Westpac Bank BSB No: 032 102, Account No: 971912.
- (d) Further to 2021 Season NoR 5, competing boats shall be berthed at MHYC Competitor berthing facilities will be available from Thursday 4th November to Monday 8th November 2021 at no additional fee. Facilities for race yachts (and any other vessels) must be pre-booked by contacting Matt Pyne 9969-1244 or marina@mhyc.com.au.
- (e) Signals made ashore shall be displayed on the flag mast at the starters box.
- (f) The Official Notice Board is in the breezeway at the entrance to the club.
- (g) The race management channel shall be VHF 72.
- (h) It is a requirement that all crews weigh in and record weights for the 2021 Australian Championships at MHYC.
- (i) The schedule of events is as follows:

- (j) The description of the marks in the NoR and General SI 8 are replaced with the following:
 - 1. The starting line will be between the signal mast of the Race Committee Signal Boat displaying an orange flag and the course side of yellow inflatable mark on the port end of the line.
 - 2. The finishing line will be between the signal mast of the Committee Vessel displaying a blue flag and a yellow inflatable mark nearby.
 - 3. Mark 1 and the Gate marks will be orange inflatable buoys.
 - 4. Mark 1a (the offset mark) will be a yellow inflatable buoy.
 - 5. The "Change Mark" will be an orange inflatable buoy with black band.
- (k) CovidSAFE Sailing - Online Crew Registration will be required each day for this event. The event will be conducted in accordance with NSW Public Health Orders.
