MHYC Inshore Series Scoring & Prizes

The following is added to the Sailing Instructions for the MHYC Inshore Series as published on page 45 of the 2024-2025 Sailing Handbook:

1 SCORING

- 1.1 The Low Point System, Appendix A of the RRS including A5.3 shall apply.
- 1.2 A casual race entrant will not receive a series score. This amends RRS A2.2.
- 1.3 Abandoned races will not be re-sailed.
- 1.4 Inshore Annual ORC, IRC & PHS Pointscore Series
Twenty (20) races are scheduled and nine (9) races are required to be completed to constitute a series. One (1) excluded score will apply after every four (4) completed races, up to a maximum of five (5) excluded scores.
- 1.5 Inshore Spring ORC, IRC & PHS Pointscore Series
Eleven (11) races are scheduled and five (5) races are required to be completed to constitute a series. One (1) excluded score will apply after every four (4) completed races, up to a maximum of two (o) excluded scores.
- 1.6 Inshore Summer ORC, IRC & PHS Pointscore Series
Nine (9) races are scheduled and four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute a series. One (1) excluded score will apply after every four (4) completed races, up to a maximum of two (2) excluded scores.
- 1.7 One Design Annual, Spring & Summer Pointscore Series
Where a One-Design class has four (4) or more entries in the MHYC Inshore Annual, Spring or Summer Pointscore Series by October 19, 2024, a One-Design Pointscore will be published with finish times drawn from divisional racing.

2 PRIZES

- 2.1 Weekly divisional prizes may be awarded at a post-race presentation in accordance with the MHYC Saturday Prizegiving Policies. Prizes not collected shall be forfeited.
- 2.2 Series awards will be awarded at the Annual Presentation.
