



Scoring & Prizegiving Policy for Wednesday Non Spinnaker Series

Scoring

The Wednesday Non Spinnaker Series is a PHS based Pursuit Handicap (PurHC) Series with a pointscore based upon finish order.

An additional pointscore shall be published using valid ORC ratings applied to each yacht's elapsed time. Where a boat does not have a non-spinnaker ORC rating, the spinnaker ORC rating may be used.

RRS A5.3 applies except that the score of DNC for boats which did not come to the starting area is scored the number of starters who are series entrants plus 2.

A casual race entrant will not receive a series score. This amends RRS A2.2.

Prizegiving

The scheduled time for Prize Presentations following Wednesday Keelboat Racing will be 1630hrs unless all divisions have completed racing before 1500hrs. In such circumstances, Prize Presentations may be conducted earlier.

Skippers may make arrangements with their crew or other boats to collect a prize on the day. Prizes will not be held for collection later than the day of the Prize Presentation.

- Third Place – Bottle of Wine
- Rules Quiz – Bottle of Wine

Number of Weekly Race Prizes:

- When there are 6 or more starters in a division, prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd.
- When there are 4-5 starters in a division, prizes will be awarded for 1st & 2nd.
- When there are 2 – 3 starters in a division, a prize will be awarded for 1st.
- When there is 1 starter in a division, no prize will be awarded.

Scoring & Prizegiving Policy for Thursday Non Spinnaker Twilight Series

Scoring

The Thursday Non Spinnaker Twilight Series is a PHS based Pursuit Handicap (PurHC) Series with a pointscore based upon finish order.

For the Thursday Twilight Women's Pointscore, a boat's elapsed time shall be used for the calculation of its racing division results using a separate PHS handicap to the boat's handicap in the main series.

RRS A5.3 applies except that DNC is scored the number of starters who are series entrants plus 2.

A casual race entrant will not receive a series score. This amends RRS A2.2.

Prizegiving

Prize Presentations will be held as soon as possible following Thursday Twilight Racing but no later than 2100hrs. In exceptional circumstances, Prize Presentations may be conducted later.

Skippers may make arrangements with their crew or other boats to collect a prize on the day. Prizes will not be held for collection later than the day of the Prize Presentation.

Weekly Race Prizes (per Division):

- First Place – Bottle of Wine

Number of Weekly Race Prizes:

Scoring & Prizegiving Policy for Friday Twilight Series

Scoring

The Friday Spinnaker Twilight Series is a fleet racing format with the pointscore based upon corrected time on PHS handicap.

RRS A5.3 applies except that DNC is scored the number of starters plus 2.

A casual race entrant will receive a series score in accordance with RRS A2.2.

Prizegiving

Prize Presentations will be held as soon as possible following Friday Twilight Racing but no later than 2100hrs. In exceptional circumstances, Prize Presentations may be conducted later.

Skippers may make arrangements with their crew or other boats to collect a prize on the day. Prizes will not be held for collection later than the day of the Prize Presentation.

- First Place – Bottle of Wine

Series Prizes (PHS):

Number of Prizes:

- When there are 2 – 3 starters in a division, a prize will be awarded for 1st on PHS.
- When there is 1 starter in a division, no prize will be awarded.



Scoring & Prizegiving Policy for MHYC Saturday Keelboat Racing & Feature Events

Scoring

The Inshore Annual Series is a fleet racing format of harbour passage and windward-leeward sprint races with the pointscore based upon corrected time on ORC, IRC and PHS handicaps.

RRS A5.3 applies. A casual race entrant will not receive a series score (this amends RRS A2.2).

Twenty two (22) pointscore races are scheduled and twelve (12) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

One (1) excluded score will apply after every four (4) completed races, up to a maximum of five (5) excluded scores.

MHYC Feature Events are PHS based Pursuit Handicap (PurHC) standalone races with results based upon finish order.

Prizegiving

The scheduled time for Prize Presentations following Saturday Keelboat Racing (not including regattas) will be 1630hrs unless all divisions have completed racing before 1530hrs. In such circumstances, Prize Presentations may be conducted earlier.

Skippers may make arrangements with their crew or other boats to collect a prize on the day. Prizes will not be held for collection later than the day of the Prize Presentation.

Weekly Race Prizes (per Handicap Division – ORC, IRC & PHS):

- First Place – Bottle of Wine
- Second Place – Bottle of Wine
- Third Place – Bottle of Wine

Number of Prizes (per Handicap Division – ORC, IRC & PHS):

Prizegiving Policy for MHYC Sunday Keelboat Racing

Scoring

The Combined Clubs Sunday Series is a fleet racing format of harbour passage and windward-leeward sprint races with the pointscore based upon corrected time on ORC, IRC and PHS handicaps.

RRS A5.3 applies. A casual race entrant will not receive a series score (this amends RRS A2.2).

Prizegiving

The scheduled time for Prize Presentations following Sunday Keelboat Racing (not including regattas) will be 1600hrs unless all divisions have completed racing before 1500hrs. In such circumstances, Prize Presentations may be conducted earlier.

Skippers may make arrangements with their crew or other boats to collect a prize on the day. Prizes will not be held for collection later than the day of the Prize Presentation.

Weekly Race Prizes (per Handicap Division – ORC, IRC & PHS):

- First Place – Bottle of Wine
- Second Place – Bottle of Wine
- Third Place – Bottle of Wine

Number of Prizes (per Handicap Division – ORC, IRC & PHS):

- When there are 6 or more MHYC starters in a handicap division, prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd on ORC, 1st on IRC, 1st on PHS and 1st on One Design.
- When there are 4 – 5 starters in a handicap division, prizes will be awarded for 1st & 2nd on ORC, 1st on IRC and 1st on PHS.
- When there are 2 – 3 starters in a handicap division, a prize will be awarded for 1st on ORC, 1st OR 1st on PHS.
- When there is 1 starter in a handicap division, no prize will be awarded.

Multiple Race Days (Sprints):

When multiple sprint races are scheduled on one day, prizes will be awarded based upon the combined results of all races sailed on that day.

Series Prizes (per Division):

- There are no series prizes or trophies awarded for the Combined Clubs Sunday Series.



Annual Prizegiving Policy

The Annual MHYC Keelboat Prize Presentations shall be scheduled on the first Saturday in May.

Annual Prizes for Saturday Racing

Includes results for the Inshore Annual Pointscore, Sydney Harbour Sprint Series & MHYC Ocean Series. Boat trophies shall be engraved with placings 1st, 2nd & 3rd where there are 4 or more boats in a handicap division. Where there are three or less boats in a handicap division, trophies will be engraved for 1st place only.

Annual Prizes for Thursday Twilight Racing

Includes results for the Pre-Christmas, Post-Christmas and Overall. Boat trophies shall be engraved with placings 1st, 2nd & 3rd where there are 4 or more boats in a division. Where there are three or less boats in a division, trophies will be engraved for 1st place only.
